() ***Elsie M. Boatman Scholarship (reduces UH tuition)*** Eligibility requirements:

- Must be a Hawaiian resident enrolled full-time as an undergraduate or graduate student in the FSHN department
- Academically meritorious, minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0
- Professionally responsible, able to demonstrate excellence in meritorious activity in the field of food science and/or human nutrition
- Financial need

() ***Carey D. Miller Award (cash award)*** Eligibility requirements:

- Enrolled in FSHN program for the last 3 semesters of the junior-senior years
- Academically meritorious, minimum GPA of 3.2/4.0
- Professionally responsible, as demonstrated by active participation in a professional organization or activity without remuneration e.g. FSHN Council, Dietetics Advisory Committee, CTAHR Ambassador, ASUH, etc.
- Able to demonstrate meritorious activity in additional areas, such as field work or research

() ***Harold M. Au and Alexander W.H. Kim Scholarship (reduces UH tuition)***

Eligibility requirements:

- Senior full-time FSHN student (12 or more credits)
- Permanent Hawaii resident
- Minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0, academic excellence and leadership skills
- Participation in extracurricular and community service in food science and/or human nutrition
