Scholarships for CTAHR New Students: Application Form
Postmarked Deadline: Friday, May 26, 2017

Scholarships will be made to full-time classified students in CTAHR for the 2017-2018 academic year. The general selection criteria are scholastic excellence, co-curricular and community involvement, educational and career goals, and financial need.

Recipients of all CTAHR scholarships and awards will be expected to volunteer to perform a few hours of service-related activities each semester. If you are awarded a scholarship, please be informed that you will abide by this expectation. Recipients of all CTAHR scholarships will also receive academic and student support to help them succeed.

The **CTAHR New Student Scholarship** is available to new freshmen and transfer students with a declared CTAHR major. Students who are selected to receive the CTAHR New Student Scholarship will be awarded a one-time \$2,000 scholarship for the academic year.

The **CTAHR Centennial Scholarship** is available to new freshmen and transfer students with a declared CTAHR major who are first-generation college students. First generation college students are defined as “first in their families attending college, whose parents have not earned a bachelor’s degree”. (If a student’s sibling has already earned a bachelor’s degree, they are no longer considered a first-generation college student.). Students who are selected to receive the CTAHR Centennial Scholarship will be awarded a one-time \$2,000 scholarship for the academic year.

The **CTAHR Native Hawaiian New Student Scholarship** is available to new freshmen and transfer students who are of Native Hawaiian ancestry with a declared CTAHR major. The CTAHR Native Hawaiian New Student Scholarship was created to support Native Hawaiian students that have an interest in supporting and strengthening families, agricultural and food systems, and the natural environment. It was also created in accordance with the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa's Strategic Plan, which supports the institution as a Native Hawaiian place of learning and an indigenous-serving institution.

Students who are selected to receive the CTAHR Native Hawaiian New Student Scholarship will be awarded a \$4,000 scholarship for their first year and are eligible to receive a \$2,000 scholarship for up to three years thereafter (incoming freshmen: 3 years, incoming sophomores: 2 years, incoming juniors: 1 year).
