1. **On-line version of "Handbook of Hawaiian Weeds** URL: <http://www.flickr.com/photos/uhmuseum/sets/72157616041949833/>. Line drawings and ID descriptions for common weeds in Hawaii.
2. **Weeds of Hawaii's Pastures and Natural Areas.** URL: <http://www.ctahr.hawaii.edu/invweed/weedsHi.html>. Good quick ID guide for weedy trees, shrubs and vines in with control measure provided.
3. **Plants of Hawaii.** URL: <http://www.hear.org/starr/images/?o=plants>. A site for identifying many common plants found in Hawaii. This site contains 8000+ copyright free high resolution images of both native and non-native plants.
4. **Hawaii Plant ID.** URL: <http://www.flickr.com/groups/hawaiiplantid/>. Allows for free membership and submission of photos to ID plants.
5. **Greenbook.** URL: <http://www.greenbook.net/>. Excellent free site for searching for pest control chemicals in specific sites. After completing user profile, allows for complex searches of pesticides based on crops and pests. Has section on organic production products. Many produce labels and MSDS available here .
6. **The Hawaii Pesticide Information Retrieval System.** URL: <http://state.ceris.purdue.edu/doc/hi/statehi.html>. UH site that contains information pertaining to pesticides currently licensed for distribution and sale in Hawaii.
7. **North Carolina Agricultural Chemicals Manual.** URL: <http://ipm.ncsu.edu/Agchem/agchem.html>. An excellent source of recommendations for agricultural chemicals in many food, fiber and ornamental crops. Although designed for crops in NC, many of the recommendations apply to users in Hawaii.
8. **CDMS.** URL: <http://www.cdms.net/LabelsMsds/LMDefault.aspx?t=>. Use the "Services" drop down menu to select Labels/MSDS to search for product labels. This site contains pdf files of many currently available pesticide labels and their associated MSDS (safe handling info.)
9. **Bayer Advanced,** URL: <http://www.bayeradvanced.com/>. Good site for home owner product for all types of pests. Useful to determine if a product is available for home owners to use.
10. **University of Florida Turfgrass Science:** <http://turf.ufl.edu>. Very comprehensive site for information on care, maintenance and research on warm season turf grass. Although information is designed for Florida, much of it applies to conditions in Hawaii.
11. **Weed Science Society of America.** URL: <http://www.wssa.net/>. In addition to being the site for national organization of weed scientists it also has a weed identification section.
